Herman Hollman Dies Early Last Evening

Burial Rites Here Friday Afternoon

Herman Hollman, 64, former Decatur resident, died at 5 o'clock Tuesday evening at the Lutheran hospital in Fort Wayne, where he had been a patient since Sunday. He had been in ill health for three months.

Mr. Hollman formerly was employed as foreman of the job printing department of the Decatur Daily Democrat, serving in that position from January of 1917 until 1935, when he moved to Fort Wayne, operating a printing shop in that city until recently, when he had been custodian of the Olive club quarters there.

He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran church in Fort Wayne.

Surviving are the wife, formerly Miss Frances Harkless of this city, and three brothers, Louis Hollman of Fort Wayne, William of Delphos, O., and George of Los Angeles, Calif.

Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at the Rodenbeck-Pook funeral home in Fort Wayne, Rev. Edwin David officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 3 p.m. Thursday.
