

Mrs. Zula D. Holloway,75, of 234 Stevenson St. a retired employee of the Decatur General Electric plant and former employee at the Adams County Memorial Hospital died at 1:55 Tuesday at the local hospital, where she had been a patient one day. She had been in ill health for several weeks.
