

Frank Hower Dies Thursday Night

E. H. Frank Hower, 74 of 1026 Patterson street, a lifelong resident of Adams county and a retired General Electric Co. employe, died at 10:20 p.m. Thursday at the Adams county memorial hospital. He had been ill two months with complications and critical for the past three weeks.
