Mrs. Rachel A. Poorman Passed Away While on Visit to Granddaughter

Bring Remains Here

Funeral Tuesday Afternoon at Home

Mrs. Rachel A. Poorman, a life-long resident of this city, with the exception of a few years spent at St. Paris, Ohio, died at the home of a granddaughter, Mrs. Ralph Rodgers, at South Whitley, Indiana, Sunday morning at 9:30, after an illness from influenza and pneumonia. The remains were brought to the home here.

Mrs. Poorman was a resident of Ninth street and had gone to South Whitley several days ago to visit the granddaughter and her family and took sick while on the visit.

Mrs. Poorman was born in Champaign county, Ohio, December 26, 1842. She was twice married, the first husband dying many years ago, and the second about a year ago. She is survived by the following children, B. F. Hower of Plymouth, William H. Hower of Boulder, Colo., and C. M. Hower of Fort Wayne. Mrs. Cinderella Thomas of Plymouth, Ill., is a sister and Frank Proctor, of Casstown, Ohio, is a brother. Mrs. Poorman had reached the advanced age of 77 years, 4 months and 29 days.

Funeral services will be held from the residence Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, and burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.

The remains will lie in state at the home from 9 o'clock in the morning until the time of the service.
