Nellie C. Jackson, 84, 338 Mercer Ave., widow of Artie L. Jackson, died at 2:25 a.m. today at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. She had been in ill health for several years.

She was a former employee of the General Electric Co., the Fairway Restaurant, and the Adams County Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Jackson was a member of the St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Jolly Housewives Homemakers Club, Senior Citizens organization, and the American Legion Auxiliary, where she was a past president of the Parley of the Auxiliary.
