

John Johnson Dies Early This Morning

John E. Johnson, 82, retired farmer residing at Monroe, died at 12:15 o'clock this morning at the Parkview memorial hospital in Fort Wayne. He had been ill for the past five years.

He was born in Adams county Dec. 18, 1877, a son of Samuel and Susanna Everhart-Johnson, and was married March 19, 1899. His wife preceded him in death June 30, 1955.

Mr. Johnson was a resident of Monroe township most of his life.
