Mrs. Mae Johnson Is Taken By Death - Funeral Services Thursday Afternoon

Mrs. Mae Johnson, 66, a lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 2 o'clock Monday afternoon at the home of her son, Ermal Johnson, two miles northwest of Decatur, where she made her home. She had been ill since January.

She was born in Adams county April 26, 1888, a daughter of Samuel and Margaret Hilyard-Workinger, and was married to Lawrence Johnson Nov. 25, 1908. Her husband died May 20, 1953.

Mrs. Johnson was a member of the Union Chapel Evangelical United Brethren church.

Surviving in addition to the son are a daughter, Mrs. Verlin Burke of Decatur; five grandchildren; two brothers, Pierce Workinger of Greenville, Mich., and Perry of Wren, O., a sister, Florence Workinger of Lima, O., and a step-sister, Mrs. Homer Smitley of Decatur. One son and two brothers are deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Thursday at the Zwick funeral home and at 2 p.m. at the Union Chapel Evangelical United Brethren church, the Rev. L. T. Norris officiating.
