EUGENE JOHNSON'S BROTHER, 47, DIES

A brother of Eugene Johnson of Bluffton, Thomas J. Johnson, Jr., 47, formerly of Monroe, who had been in Tehran, Iran, the past 10 years, died at 4:45 a.m. Monday in Indiana University Medical Hospital in Indianapolis. He had been flown to the hospital three days ago.

He was superintendent of the American School in Tehran and was also president of the Near East - South Asia Overseas Schools.

Other survivors include the wife, the former Neva Crownover; three daughters, Mrs. Ray Harding of Joplin, Mo., and Shelly and Jana, at home; three sisters, Mrs. Archie Heddington of Decatur, and Mrs. Marvin Lampe and Mrs. Gilbert Brookhart, both of Fort Wayne, and two other brothers, Lawrence Johnson of Fort Wayne and Paul Johnson of South Whitley.
