DECATUR, Ind. - Clyde Jones, 66, of Rt. 3, Decatur, died at 5:30 p.m. Monday at his residence. He had been in failing health for six years. Mr. Jones was the father of Mrs. Glen O. (Ellen) Mosier of Ohio City.
