CURTIS P. JONES, 76, of New Haven, died on Saturday, May 23, 2009, at 10:35 p.m., at Dekalb Memorial Hospital, Auburn. Born Feb. 10, 1933, in Adams County, son of the late William and Myrtle M. (Manley) Jones, Curtis first attended school at Mt. Pleasant in Decatur (a one-room schoolhouse), where he met Judy McKean, at age 7. Judy moved to Decatur and attended Decatur High School. Curtis soon followed, moving to Decatur with his mother. Curtis started high school at Monmouth, but later transferred to Decatur High School, where he was reunited with Judy. They both graduated from Decatur High School in 1951. Life took them in different directions, but they were reunited again in 1957, began dating, and were eventually married on Dec. 12, 1959, in Decatur. Curtis retired from International Harvester after 24 years of service, in 1983. Following the closing of International Harvester, he worked at the Auburn Foundry until 1998. He was a member of the Wayne Masonic Lodge 25, Fort Wayne and Redman's Lodge, Decatur. He is survived by his wife, Judith Jones of New Haven; children, D'Ann M. (Robert) Cour, Gregory C. Jones and Sandra R. (Darren) Bailey, all of Fort Wayne and P. David Jones of New Haven; two grandchildren, Jacqueline Cour and Travis Briner; and one sister, Doris Koomler of Decatur.
