Patrick E. Kenney, 33, route 8 (Barrington Woods), maintenance supervisor at Central Soya and an employee there 14 years, was dead on arrival at 2:58 p.m. Friday at Adams County Memorial Hospital.

He collapsed at home a short time earlier, and although he had been ill, death was unexpected.

A 1969 graduate of Bellmont High School, he attended Ball State University and was presently attending Indiana-Purdue in Fort Wayne, nearing completion of an associate degree in business management.

Mr. Kenney was a member of Decatur Zion Lutheran Church, Moose Lodge 1311, where he was chairman of the Degree Team and held a fellowship degree in the Legion of the Moose.

Born in Decatur on Nov. 5, 1950, he was the son of William E. and Mary L. Crosby-Kenney (his father is deceased), and was united in marriage on Sept. 8, 1973, to Joyce A. Thatcher.

Survivors include the wife; two daughters, Jamee Michelle and Abbee Lachelle, both at home, the mother and stepfather, Mary and Gilbert Thieme, route 5, Decatur; one brother, John W. Kenney, Decatur; three sisters, Mrs. Donald (Kathryn) Steuernagel, Poway, Calif.; Mrs. Daniel T. (Julie) Miller, Decatur; Miss Laura J. Kenney, route 5, Decatur; three stepsisters, Mrs Beverly DeBolt, Decatur; Mrs. James (Karen) Reidenbach, Frankfort, Ind.; Mrs. Denny (Susan) Baker, route 6, Decatur; a stepbrother, Lanny G. One brother, James Michael Kenney, died on Dec. 2, 1966.
