

Vestal (Stan) E. Kling (January 4, 1921 - September 3, 2009)

Vestal E. (Stan) Kling, 88, of Raymore, Missouri formerly of Decatur died Thursday, September 3, 2009 at Belton Research Hospital in Belton, Missouri. He was born on January 4, 1921 in Breman, IN to the late Harry E. & Florence G. (Jeandervan) Kling. On August 2, 1947 he married Edith C. (Baker) Kling. She preceded him in death on July 3, 2004.
