Sherman R. Koos, 71, 707 Mercer Ave., died at 11 a.m. Saturday in Adams County Memorial Hospital; he had been ill nine months and in the hospital nine days.

Born April 16, 1913, in Union Township, he was the son of Harvey and Gladys Steele Koos, and was married November 4, 1950, to the former Ruth Hurless, who survives.

Mr. Koos retired in 1978 after 26 years of service at Phelps Dodge in Fort Wayne. A member of Union Chapel United Methodist Church, he belonged to the Decatur Elks Lodge.

The only survivors, other than the widow, are two nieces, Mrs. Steve (Pam) Hakes of route 1, Decatur, and Mrs. Pat (Nancy) Loshe of Decatur. A brother, Guy L. Koos, died in 1976.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at Zwick-Boltz & Jahn Funeral Home, with Rev. Dale Bardsley officiating; burial will be in Decatur Cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 1:30 today. Preferred memorials are to the Union Chapel UM Church.
