

**Mrs. Frank J. Krick Is Taken By Death
Funeral Services Friday Afternoon**

Mrs. Eva C. Krick, 72, of 324 Line street, widow of Frank J. Krick, died at 4:15 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital after an illness of six weeks of complications.

A lifelong resident of Adams county, she was born in Root township July 3, 1880, a daughter of Perry and Eda Butler-Elzey, and was married May 20 1899. She had lived in Decatur since 1905. Her husband died Sept. 6, 1952.

Mrs. Krick was a member of the First Methodist church and the Order of Eastern Star. Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Pauline Hyde of Roselle, N. J.; three sons, Robert H. and Joseph A.
