Mary Agnes Krick, 95, Detroit, Mich., sister of Virgil M. "Pete" Krick of Decatur, died at 1:45 p.m. Friday at the Middle Belt Nursing Home Center, Westland Mich. She had been a resident of Detroit for 40 years.

She was a retired manager of the Michigan Insurance Audit Bureau and also a member of the Metropolitan Methodist Church, Detroit. She was also a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Highland Park, Mich., and the P.E.O. Sisterhood Supreme Chapter One, Detroit.
