Mary L. Kunowich dies this morning

Mrs. Mary L. Kunowich, 79, wife of Adam P. Kunowich, 216 North Ninth street, died at 4:50 a.m. today at the Adams county memorial hospital, where she had been a patient two weeks.

She was born in Adams county Jan. 12, 1890, a daughter of Perry S. and Mary A. Merryman-Johnson, and was married to Adam P. Kunowich Dec. 18, 1923.

Mrs. Kunowich graduated from the Monroe high school, and taught in schools in Mercer county, O. She also taught music and was associated with her husband for a number of years in operation of music stores in Decatur and Huntington.

She was an active member of the First Christian church and the Pythian Sisters.

Surviving are her husband and a number of nieces and nephews. Three brothers and two sisters are deceased.
