MYRON V. LEHMAN, 88, of Decatur died yesterday in Adams County Memorial Hospital.

The Berne native retired in 1970 after teaching and coaching at Monmouth High School from 1943-1950, Pleasant Mills School from 1950-1958, being principal of Nead Elementary School near Peru from 1959-1961, and teaching in East Allen County and Fort Wayne Community schools from 1962-1970. He was a member of the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. His wife, Frieda, died last July.

Surviving are a daughter, Colleen Slaughter of Decatur; a son, Raymond J. of New Haven; brothers, Carl of Berne and Palmer of Decatur; 13 grandchildren; and 20 great-grandchildren.
