

## Norman G. Lenhart Is Taken By Death

Norman G. Lenhart, 84, well known Decatur man, died at 12:15 o'clock Friday afternoon at the Masonic home at Franklin. Death was attributed to complications. He had been in failing health for some time. He resided at 120 North Third street until entering the Masonic home Nov. 30, 1960.

Mr. Lenhart was a 63-year member of the Masonic lodge in this city. He was also a member of the Scottish Rite, York Rite, Knights Templar, Shrine, Odd Fellows lodge, and the Order of Eastern Star.

Born in Adams county Dec. 8, 1876, he was a son of John H. and Tilla Stevens-Lenhart, and graduated from Taylor University.

Surviving are two nieces, Mrs. Charles (Velma) Bowman of Bluffton, and Mrs. Victor (Alice) Baltzell of Decatur route 4, and one nephew, Orval Lenhart of Monroe.
