FORMER MONROE PRINCIPAL DIES

Robert Mann, Prominent School Teacher, Dies Suddenly

Robert Mann, well known former school teacher in Decatur and Adams county schools, died suddenly of a heart attack Friday morning at the hospital in Paulding, Ohio.

Mr. Mann, who resided near Cecil, O., for the past several years was visiting his wife, who underwent an operation at Paulding several days ago, when he suffered the fatal seizure.

Mr. Mann taught in the Decatur high school at two different times and also formerly served as principal of the high school at Kirkland, Pleasant Mills and Monroe.

Surviving in addition to his wife are four sons, Ted Mann of Decatur, Wendell, a student at Purdue University, Robert of St. Paul, Minn., and Ray of Los Angeles, Cal., one daughter, Mrs. Paul Pressler of Los Angeles, four sisters, Mrs. George Sprague of Decatur, Mrs. Jess Singleton of Root township, Mrs. J.
