

Wilson J. Mann (January 16, 1913 - February 29, 2004)

Mr. Wilson J. Mann, 91, passed away, February 29, 2004. Wilson Mann of Monroe, Indiana, passed away at 2:25pm at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, Decatur, IN.
