Marcile Martin, 94 years old and a lifelong resident of Decatur who resided at Adams Woodcrest passed away on Sunday, October 23, 2016 at Adams Woodcrest.

She was born on Sunday, October 15, 1922 in Decatur, Indiana, the daughter of the late Frederick Christener and the late Flona (Davidson) Christener. She married Rev.
