

Fort Wayne Journal Gazette, Allen County, Indiana; August 21, 1919

Grant McGill, aged 36, residing near the Ohio state line, and well known in this city, died shortly after midnight last night at his home. The deceased was a sufferer from apoplexy, and was in a sickly condition for the last week. Last night, not feeling very well, he retired early from an ice cream social, and when the family returned home, they found him lying on the bed unconscious. Everything possible was done to relieve him, a doctor being summoned, but it was too late to save him, as a blood vessel had burst. He is survived by the widow and two small children. Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from the United Brethren church in Ohio, and burial made in the Decatur Cemetery.
