

MONROE WOMAN EXPIRES TODAY

**Mrs. John McKean Dies of Heart Trouble This Afternoon
Ill Two Years**

Mrs. John McKean, 57, died of heart trouble at 12:30 o'clock this afternoon, at her home, one mile west of Monroe. Mrs. McKean had been in ill health for the last two years.
