

## **Obit of Reba Roop McManama Barany - no name of paper or date on clipping; She died Friday, 21 Jun 1963**

Mrs. Reba Barany, 58, of Crooked Lake, and a native and former resident of Decatur, died at 6:50 o'clock Friday morning at the Cameron hospital in Angola, where she had been a patient two weeks. Born in Decatur July 12, 1904, she was a daughter of Jess and Eva Reed-Roop. She was first married to Omar McManama (sic), who preceded her in death March 26, 1954. She later married to Carl Barany, who survives.

She formerly owned and operated the McManama grocery in this city and also was an employee of the Decatur plant of the General Electric Co. She later owned and operated the Green Parrott restaurant at Waterloo. Mrs. Barany was a member of the First Methodist church in Decatur and the Women of the Moose at Angola.

Surviving in addition to her husband are two daughters, Mrs. George (Virginia) Ray of Joplin, MO, and Mrs. Marshall (Barbara) McCann of Auburn; one son, Cletus McManama of Angola; six grandchildren; one great-grandchild; three brothers, Ralph E. and Brice D. Roop, both of Decatur, and Raymond Roop of Gulfport, MS, and one sister, Mrs. Edward (Ruth) Coffee of Chicago.
