Glen B. McMillen, 86, of Pleasant Mills, a veteran of World War I and a General Electric Co. employee for 31 years until his retirement at the age of 60, died at 5:25 p.m. Tuesday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where he had been a patient for one day. He had been in ill health since the first of the year and had been residing in the Decatur Community Care Center.

He was a member of the Pleasant Mills United Methodist Church, and American Legion Post 43, Decatur.

Born in Grant County, Ind., on Jan. 25, 1895, he was the son of Asa and Sadie A. Custer-McMillen, and was united in marriage in February of 1919 to Bernice Nuttle; she died Jan. 9, 1978.

Survivors include three sons, Robert G. of Fort Wayne, Dean D. of Willshire, O. and Richard L. McMillen of Pleasant Mills; 12 grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren. One brother and one sister preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be conducted at 3:30 p.m. Friday at the Zwick-Boltz & Jahn Funeral Home, with Rev. James E. Cheney officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur Cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 7 p.m. today.
