

**MRS. C. W. MERRYMAN DIES AT MONROE**

**Death Follows Illness of Four Weeks Due to Diabetes**

Mrs. C. W. Merryman, age 63 years, a life-long resident of Adams county, died at her home in Monroe, early Tuesday, following an illness of sugar diabetes. Mrs. Merryman had been in ill health for the last few years, but her last illness lasted only four weeks.

Mrs. Merryman was a daughter of Robert and Sophia Andrews and was born in Adams County, November 2, 1861. Practically all of her life was spent in Adams county. For the last nineteen years Mr. and Mrs. Merryman have resided in Monroe. They were married 42 years ago last November. Mrs. Merryman was a member of the Methodist church at Monroe.

The husband, C. W. Merryman; one adopted daughter, Mrs. Loma Foster of Monroe; one sister, Mrs. O. C. Fink, of Fort Wayne, and one brother, Leslie B. Andrews, of Indianapolis, survive.

Funeral services will be held from the Methodist church in Monroe at 1:30 o'clock Thursday afternoon, the Rev. S. I. Zechiel, pastor of the Monroe M. E. church, officiating. Burial will be made in Decatur Cemetery.
