Loma L. Miller, 95, rural Bluffton, died at 11:45 a.m. Tuesday, March 21, 2006 at her daughter's home in rural Kokomo.

Born in Monroe on Dec. 5, 1910 to George A. and Eliza Johnston Hahnert, she married Lee T. Miller on Nov. 29, 1934 in Monroe; he died July 5, 1989.

A 1929 graduate of Monroe High School, she was a homemaker and a beekeeper. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Bluffton where she taught Sunday School and was active in WSCS and the UMW. She was a member of the Loyal Neighbors Club, the Farm Bureau Pet & Hobby Club, and was a volunteer at the Wells County Food Bank for 14 years.
