

Mrs. J. M. Miller Dies Tuesday Night

Funeral Services Saturday Afternoon

Mrs. Sadie M. Miller, 81, prominently known Decatur lady and widow of the late Dr. J. M. Miller, died last night at 9:45 o'clock at the Adams county memorial hospital.

Death was attributed to a heart attack and complications, following a fall in her home last Thursday, in which she sustained a fractured hip.

Mrs. Miller was well known in the city's social and civic circles. She was a member of the Rebekah lodge, the Pythian Sisters lodge and the needle club of that organization, and of the Decatur historical club.

She was born in Root township on September 3, 1865, the daughter of Jonathan and Ellen Mallonee-Archbold. She was married to Dr. Miller on December 25, 1891. He preceded her in death seven years ago.

For a short time following her marriage she resided in Mendon, O., where her husband was engaged in the practice of medicine. They returned here in 1897.

She was a member of the First Methodist church.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. W. H. Gilpen, Fort Wayne, and Mrs. Homer D. Lower, Decatur; a brother, H. L. Archbold of Los Angeles. Three children, a step-daughter, six brothers and sisters preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the home, 224 South Second street, and 2:30 p.m. at the First Methodist church. The Rev. R. W. Graham, of Muncie, will officiate. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.

The body will be returned from the Black funeral home to the residence Thursday afternoon and may be viewed there after 4 p.m. until time for the services.

The casket will not be opened at the church.
