Alice C. Moses - Affolder, 97 years old of Decatur, Indiana, passed away early Saturday, November 26, 2016 at her residence.

She was born on Sunday, July 27, 1919 in Adams County, Indiana the daughter of the late Louis Holle and the late Caroline (Franke) Holle. On April 5, 1941 she married Richard K. Moses in Fort Wayne, Indiana and he preceded her in death on July 13, 1990. She married V.W.
