

DALE D. MOSES, 85, FORMER COMMISSIONER, DIES THIS MORNING.

DALE D. MOSES, 85, of route 3, well known Adams county resident and a former county commissioner, died at 4:30 a.m. this morning at the Decatur Community Care Center. He had been in failing health for the past two years.

Mr. MOSES served as a county commissioner from 1940 until 1948, and was one of the few Republicans ever elected to this post. He owned and operated Moses Dairy From 1930 to 1952. Mr. MOSES and his grandson James MOSES, established the Grant County Mobile Home Sales at Marion and he was active in the business until several years ago. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church.

He was born in Denver, Colorado, on 9 September 1887, the son of James C. and Emily DAILEY-MOSES, and was married to Florence KUNKEL on 14 June 1911. She preceded him in death on 26 September 1966.

Surviving are three children, James C. MOSES, Richard K. MOSES, and Mrs. Wayne (Margaret) SCHNEPF, all of route 3; one foster sister, Mrs. W. R. McCOY, of Rockford, ILL.; one brother Carroll MOSES of Fort Wayne; seven grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 3:30 p.m. Sunday at the Zwick Funeral Home, with Rev. Robert VanderHart officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home after 2 p.m. Saturday.

Dale D. Moses dies this morning

Dale D. Moses, 85, R.R. 3, Decatur, long a prominent dairy operator died at 4:30 a.m. today at the Decatur Community Care Center after and illness of two years.

He operated the Moses Dairy in Decatur from 1930 to 1952, distributing the milk not only to Decatur customers but on rural routes as well. He was a member of the Adams county board of commissioners from 1940 to 1948. He and a grandson, James K. Moses, established the Grand County Mobile Home Sales at Marion and helped operate this business until his illness.

Mr. Moses was born Sept. 9, 1887, in Denver, Colorado, the son of James C. and Emily Dailey Moses. He married Florence Kunkel, June 14, 1911. She preceded in death in 1966.

Surviving are two sons, James C. and Richard K. Moses and a daughter, Mrs. Wayne (Margaret) Schnepf, all of R.R. 3, Decatur; a brother, Carroll Moses of Fort Wayne and a foster sister, Mrs. W. R. McCoy, Rockford, Illinois. There are seven grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.
