Mrs. Ray Mosure Dies of Cancer

A resident of 57 Hi-Lo Dr., prior to moving to Woodruff, Wis., in 1976, Mrs. Raymond W. (Margaret) Mosure, 66, died at 8:40 p.m. Friday in Howard Young Medical Center at Woodruff, Wis. Ill over an extended period of time, Mrs. Mosure's death was attributed to cancer.

Her husband will be remembered as having operated for many years Ray's Lunch at 116 West Washington St., now Maudie's Place, and who served several years on the Bluffton City Council.

A member of the First United Methodist Church, Mrs. Mosure was born Sept. 14, 1910 in Wells County to the late Chauncey Oliver and Mrs. Martha Buckmaster Oliver of Woodruff. Her marriage to Mr. Mosure, who died Oct. 31, 1975, took place in LaGrange March 2, 1929.
