Mrs. Mounsey, Decatur Route 5, Dies of Cancer

A native of Wells County, Mrs. Earl L. (Virginia E.) Mounsey, 65, died at 3 a.m. Sunday at her home on Decatur Route 5. Ill since May, her death was attributed to cancer.

Born April 2, 1911, she was an adopted daughter of Ora and Ella Platt Wilcoxson. Her marriage to Mr. Mounsey, who survives, took place Oct. 12, 1935.

A member of the Union Chapel United Methodist Church, Mrs. Mounsey also belonged to Pocahontas Lodge 355.
