EDGAR W. MURRAY PASSED AWAY TODAY

Edgar W. Murray, 65 years old, a resident of Warren for the past five years, died at his home at 1859 Clermont Ave. today at 11:27 a.m., his death resulting from a stroke of apoplexy, which overtook him suddenly this morning. Mr. Murray had been in ill health for several years, suffering with complications and since coming to Warren had been unable to leave his home but very little. He had spent his life previous to coming here in Anderson and Decatur, Ind. He was a member of the Presbyterian church and was fraternally afflicted with the Loyal Order of Moose. Friends of the family extend their sympathy to them in their bereavement.

He is survived by his wife, four sons, Harry, Lawrence, Robert and Richard and one daughter, Mrs. L. E. Sowers, all of Warren. The remains will be taken tonight to Decatur, Ind., where funeral services will be held followed by the burial.
