Fay Mutschler, 85, a resident of Swiss Village, Berne, for the last two years and formerly of N. 16th St., and also of Hamilton Lake, died at 5:38 a.m. today at Adams County Memorial Hospital, where she had been a patient one day. She had been in failing health three years.

She operated Mutschler Packing Co. in Decatur from 1935-42 after her husband's death, along her brother-in-law, Ed Mutschler. She was a member of Zion United Church of Christ, Women of the Moose, and American Legion 43 Auxiliary.

Born on June 2, 1903, in St. Marys Township, she was the daughter of Elzey and Fanny Standiford Jackson, and was married to Albert F. Mutschler on June 29, 1924; he died April 3, 1935.

Survivors include a son, Robert F. Mutschler, route 2 Decatur; three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
