**Josiah Myers Dies Wednesday Evening - Funeral Services Sunday Afternoon**

Josiah Myers, 79, retired farmer, died at 9 o'clock Wednesday night at his home, 122 South Ninth street, following a long illness. His condition had been serious for the past eight weeks.

He was born in Blue Creek township Sept. 12, 1873, a son of James C. and Fredricka Loy-Myers, and was married to Rosa August April 26, 1898. They lived in Blue Creek township until five years ago, when they moved to Decatur.

Mr. Myers attended the Union United Brethren church near Willshire, O. and was a member of the Knights of Pythias lodge at Willshire.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two daughters, Mrs. Nellie White of Decatur and Mrs. Myrtle Burdick of Dayton, O.; two sons, James V. Myers of Blue Creek township and Harold R. Myers of Anderson; eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. Two brothers and one sister are deceased.
