Grover Odle Rites Monday Afternoon Decatur Resident Is Taken By Death

Funeral services will be held Monday for Grover Odle, 59, a lifelong resident of Decatur and Adams county, who died at 2 o'clock Friday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital following an illness of five days of a heart ailment.

He had been employed as a stationary engineer at the Central Soya Co. for many years and was engineer of the company's boiler house.

Born in Adams county May 28, 1891, he was a son of Mr. and Mrs. Aaron Odle. He was a member of the Church of God.

Surviving are his wife, Nettie; four sons, Richard of Fort Wayne, Robert and Max of Decatur and Grover Odle, Jr., at home; three daughters, Mrs. Isabelle Anderson, Mrs. Eileen Miller and Mrs. Kathleen Shaffer, all of Fort Wayne; seven grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Myrtle Fuller of Fort Wayne and Mrs. Agnes Sudduth of Decatur.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Monday at the home, 230 North Seventh street, and at 2 o'clock at the Church of God, the Rev. Dwight R. McCurdy officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. The body will be removed from the Gillig & Doan funeral home to the residence, where friends may call after 7 o'clock this evening.
