Mrs. Cora S. Pence Dies This Morning

Funeral services on Friday Morning

Mrs. Cora Pence, 78, of 234 North Fifth Street, died at 10:20 o'clock this morning at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. She had been in failing health for the past year.

She was born in Kirkland Township October 6, 1877, a daughter of James and Victoria LeBrun-Steele, and was married to Arthur Pence November 27, 1923. Her husband preceded her in death January 21, 1946, after which she returned to Decatur from Kendallville.
