

Mrs. Chas. Peterson Dies Last Evening

Mrs. Maude T. Peterson, 76, of 521 Penn street, died at 8:30 o'clock Wednesday evening at the South View rest home at Bluffton. She had been in failing health for three years with complications.

A lifelong resident of Adams county, she was born in St. Mary's township Nov. 15, 1883, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A. M. Fuller, and was married to Charles A. Peterson in August of 1901. Her husband preceded her in death.
