CLAIRE REDDING'S BROTHER, NYLE, 73, DIES OF CANCER

Brother of Claire Redding of Bluffton, H. N. (Nyle) Redding, 73, of Clearwater, Fla., died at 7 p.m. Monday in a hospital in that city. Death, due to cancer, followed an illness of three years.

A retired engineer, Mr. Redding was an active member of the United Methodist Church in Clearwater.

Born in Bluffton in 1907, he was a son of Francis and Celesta Brown Redding. His marriage to Helen Eady, who survives, took place in December 1933.

In addition to the wife and brother in Bluffton, he is survived by two sons, John Redding of California and Lee Redding of Columbus, O.; two other brothers, Philip Redding and Dwight Redding, both of Fort Wayne; two sisters, Mrs. William (Obbie) Rubert of Sandusky, O., and Mrs. John (Edith) Allendroph of Fort Wayne; a half-brother, Pressel Redding of Greenfield and eight grandchildren.

Cremation has taken place. Memorial services will be held Thursday in Clearwater.

At 1:30 p.m. Monday, memorial services will be at the Winteregg-Linn and Haggard Funeral Home in Decatur with inurnment to be in a Decatur cemetery.
