Helen G. Rice, 87, route 3, Decatur, died suddenly Friday morning at her daughter's home in Indianapolis after having been ill one week. She was born on September 12, 1904 in Whitley County to Lewis and Ada Raber Chapman and married Ralph W. Rice on June 1, 1924. Mr. Rice, who served eight years as Root Township Trustee and was also Highway Superintendent, died on December 15, 1976.

She was a homemaker and a member of Union Chapel United Methodist church and the Home Economics Club.

Surviving are her daughter, Mrs. Leslie (Gwendolyn) Ohmit, Indianapolis; a son, Richard C.
