Robinson Rites Set for Saturday

Funeral services will be held here Saturday for Wilbur H. Robinson, 67, 428 Closs street, who died suddenly at 6:10 p.m. Tuesday while on a business trip in Dallas, Tex.

Mr. Robinson had been employed for the 25 years as a cereal chemist with the Dawn Donut Co. of Jackson, Mich. He was formerly associated with the Decatur Bakery, and had resided here for 38 years.

Born in Rockford, O., Jan. 12, 1904, he was a son of David E. and Anna Maria Riley-Robinson, and was married to Dorothy N. Johnston Dec. 31, 1932.

Mr. Robinson was a member of the Zion United Church of Christ, Jackson lodge 17, F&AM, the Decatur Elks lodge, and the American Association of Cereal Chemists.

Surviving in addition to his wife are three daughters, Mrs. Thomas (Sunya) Garner of Monroe, Mrs. Eugene (Marilyn) Vetter of Decatur route 2, and Mrs. Gerry (Karen) Hilty of Decatur; two sons, Major Ronald L. Robinson of Ft. Lee, Virginia, and Gary H. Robinson of Decatur route 1; 15 grandchildren and two nieces. Two sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:30 p.m. Saturday at the Winteregg-Linn funeral home, with Rev. William C. Feller officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.
