

**Decatur Daily Democrat, Adams County, Indiana; Thursday, May 10, 1979**

Herbert W. Rodenbeck, 75, who resided in the town of Monmouth and retired seven years ago from the Philadelphia Ship Yards, and also a former employee of the Penn Central Railroad, died at 12:30 a.m. Wednesday at his residence.

He was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church in Decatur.

Born in Adams County on Jan. 7, 1904, he was the son of Henry and Sophia Berning-Rodenbeck, and was married on Dec. 27, 1930 to Catherine Hoffman, who died Feb. 10, 1976.
