G. W. RUCKMAN DIES SATURDAY

Retired Carpenter Dies of Heart Attack at Home Here

George W. Ruckman, 78, well known retired carpenter of this city died Saturday afternoon at 12:30 o'clock at his home, 1029 North Second street. Death was caused by a heart attack.

The deceased was born in Ohio, January 10, 1855, the son of John and Sarah Ruckman. He had lived in and near the city for the past 64 years. He was a member of the First M. E. church of this city.

Surviving besides the widow, Elizabeth, are two children, Delma Ruckman of Hudson and Mrs. Charles Knodle of this city. One son, William, is deceased. A brother, J. C. Ruckman, of Farmdale, Ohio; seven grandchildren and six great grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the home and at 3:30 o'clock at the First M. E. church here. Burial will be made in the Decatur cemetery. The Rev. R. W. Graham will officiate.

The body was returned to the home from the Gillig and Dean funeral parlors, and may be viewed until time for the funeral.
