MRS. SCHWARTZ DIES THURSDAY

Funeral Service for Local Woman is on Sunday Afternoon

Mrs. Elizabeth D. Schwartz, age 43, wife of Peter D. Schwartz of northeast of Berne residing on the Benjamin Habegger farm, passed away Thursday afternoon at 3:50 o'clock.

She had been critically ill for about ten weeks and during the past week little hope was held for recovery. Death was caused by carcinoma.

The deceased was born September 20, 1893, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David C. Nussbaum. She was a life long resident of this community.

June 18, 1916 she was married to Peter D. Schwartz who survives with the following children: Gerhart R., Chester H., LeRoy D., Frances M., Raymond L., Anna Louise and Rosemary Elizabeth.

Brothers and sisters who survive are Samuel, Jacob, Philip and Menno Nussbaum, all of this community. One sister preceded.

Funeral services will be held Sunday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home and at 2:00 o'clock at a church to be announced later.

SCHWARTZ RITES SUNDAY

Funeral services for Mrs. Peter D. Schwartz Held Here

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Mennonite church for Mrs. Peter D. Schwartz, aged 43, who died at her home late Thursday. Rev. C. H. Suckau officiated at the services. The funeral sermon was preached in German. Burial was in the M.R.E. Cemetery.

Mrs. Schwartz had been ill for ten weeks, and her condition was critical for several days before her death. A post mortem, held Friday disclosed that death was caused by carcinoma. She suffered greatly during her illness. The Schwartz family lives on the former Ben Habegger farm, northeast of Berne.

Elizabeth Nussbaum Schwartz was born in Wabash township, Sept. 20, 1893, a daughter of David C. and Marian Habegger Nussbaum. Most of her life was spent in Monroe township, and on June 18, 1916, she was married to Peter D. Schwartz. He survives and the following children, all at home: Gerhart, Chester, Leroy, Frances, Raymond, Anna Louise and Rosemary Elizabeth. The father, David C. Nussbaum, also survives, and four brothers, Sam D., Jacob, Philip and Menno Nussbaum, all of this community. The step-grandmother survives, Mrs. Catherine Habegger. The mother and one sister preceded.

DEATH CLAIMS MRS. SCHWARTZ

Mrs. Peter D. Schwartz Dies At Monroe Township Home

Mrs. Elizabeth Schwartz, aged 43, wife of Peter D. Schwartz, died at her home in Monroe Township Thursday afternoon at 4 o'clock. Death was due to complications.

The deceased had been ill for the past 10 weeks. She was born in Wabash Township on September 20, 1893, the daughter of David and Maria Nussbaum. the father is still living, the mother having preceded her in death.

Surviving besides the husband are the following children: Gerhart, Chester, LeRoy, Frances, Raymond, Rosemary and Anna, all at home.

Four brothers, Samuel, Jacob, Phillip and Menno, all of the Berne community, also survive.
