DECATUR - Kenneth J. Secaur, 57, of Rt. 5, Decatur, died at 11:30 a.m. Sunday in Lutheran Hospital, Ft. Wayne, following an extended illness.

Born August 3, 1913, in Willshire, he was a son of Grover C. and Goldie M. (Miller) Secaur. On May 19, 1933 he married Lucille DeBolt. His widow and mother survive.
