Mrs. Noah Sheets Dies Unexpectedly

Mrs. Mary E. Sheets, 69, wife of Noah T. Sheets, 915 Dierkes street, died suddenly at 1:10 o'clock Saturday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital, shortly after she became ill at her home. She had not been ill and death was unexpected.

She was born in Decatur July 17, 1893, a daughter of William B. and Olie Hollopeter-Teeple, and was married to Noah T. Sheets Oct. 28, 1915.

Mrs. Sheets was a member of the Trinity Evangelical United Brethren church.

Surviving in addition to her husband are three daughters, Mrs. Clarence (Helen) Morgan, Mrs. Donald (Alice) Harmon and Mrs. Lloyd (Martha) Reef, all of Decatur; four sons, Robert W., Doyle L., and David L. Sheets, all of Fort Wayne, and Richard E. Sheets of Celina, O.; 14 grandchildren, and one sister, Mrs. Bessie Conway of Cedarville. A son, Raymond Sheets, was killed while serving in the Army at Metz, France, Oct. 9, 1944, during World War II. A grandson, a brother and a sister are also deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Zwick funeral home, the Rev. J. O. Penrod officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home until time of the services.
