

## Luther Singleton dies unexpectedly

Luther J. Singleton, 52, an employe of the Central Soya Co. in this city for many years, died at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Adams county memorial hospital, shortly after suffering a heart attack at his home one mile south of Monroe.

Born in Root township Sept. 27, 1913, he was a son of Mrs. Mary Letitia Singleton. He graduated from Decatur high school in 1934 and was married to Dortha Strickler Dec. 25, 1936.

Mr. Singleton had been employed in the M. & R. department at Central Soya since 1939. He was a member of the Church of God.

Surviving are his wife; one son, Gordon Singleton of Fort Wayne; three daughters, Miss Phyllis Singleton, at home, and Mrs. Kenneth (Kay) Martin and Mrs. Lynford (Annie) Weiland, both of Monroe route 1; and four grandchildren.

Funeral services will be conducted at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Zwick funeral home, with Rev. Huston Bever, Jr., officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.
