WILLIAM SLUSHER DIES THIS MORNING

William Slusher, 63, of 115 1/2 North Sixth Street, former employee of the Nine Mile Lumber Mill, died at 5:20 a.m. today at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. He had been hospitalized one week.

Born in Allen County on Nov. 2, 1909, he was the son of James and Louisa Deboy-Slusher, and was married on September 28, 1935 to Marcella Rupert. She died on March 12, 1971.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Larady (Margaret) Brown of Wren, O., and one son, Robin L.
