ILL A LONG TIME

Death Came Saturday to Margaret Smith, Widow of Isaac Smith

SEVENTY YEARS OLD

Funeral Tuesday Afternoon from the Calvary Church -- Burial Here

Margaret Eleanor Cowan Smith, widow of Isaac Smith, died Saturday afternoon at three o'clock at her home six miles east of Decatur, in St. Marys township. She had been ill for some time following a paralytic stroke but death was due directly to chronic interstitial nephritis.

Mrs. Smith was seventy years, eleven months and fourteen days of age. She was born July 17, 1848, and was a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Israel Cowan.

Her husband died January 26, 1915, and a son is also deceased. She is survived by two daughters, Miss Jennie Smith at home; and Mrs. Delbert Walters. She also has one sister, who lives in the west; also a number of half-brothers and sisters.

The funeral will be Tuesday afternoon at two o'clock from the Calvary church, with the Rev. Baumgartner, Evangelical minister, officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery.
