### **Mrs. Amanda Snell Dies Friday Night - Funeral Services Tuesday Afternoon**

Mrs. Amanda Snell, 31, lifelong resident of Adams County, died at 10:30 o'clock Friday night at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where she had been a patient for the past two weeks. Death was attributed to leukemia.

Her husband, T/4 Clement F. Snell, is stationed with the United States Army in France.

She was born in Kirkland Township August 2, 1914, the daughter of Otto D. and Caroline Kirchener Bieberich. She was married February 17, 1940, at Bellview, Ky.

Mrs. Snell was a member of the Zion Luthean Church and was employed at the G. E. plant until ill health forced her retirement.

She is survived by the husband, the parents, and the following brothers and sisters: Oscar Bieberich of Magley, Mrs. Metha Hilpert of near Decatur, T/Sgt. Henry of Camp Blanding, Fla., Pfc.
